## The UN climate policy is based on severe errors!

UN think they can do something about the climate by cutting human emissions, primarily CO2. Then one commits the grave mistake of believing that it affects the insulating properties of the atmosphere.

They claim that in industrial times, humans created a lot of CO2 emissions through the use of fossil fuels from oil. The claim is that the increase in the amount of CO2 in the atmosphere was large and is due to human emissions of CO2 alone. It is true that it was large, in 150 years the amount increased by 50% (assuming that the amount was 280 ppm pre-industrial).

This large increase could only be explained through the large increase in human emissions during the industrial age, they say.

The mistake that is made is to ignore natural emissions. And, that since humans discovered fire, they have released CO2. Natural and man-made emissions were also pre-industrial.

Today, natural emissions make up 96% of the total, while humans make up only 4%. This was also the situation pre-industrial.

The point is that only a small part of the increase in CO2 in the atmosphere comes from human emissions.

If you want to do something about the increase in the amount of CO2 in the atmosphere, you must also cut natural emissions.

## Cutting only human emissions has practically no effect!

In addition, it should be mentioned that CO2 in the atmosphere contributes to the insulating properties of the atmosphere and participates in the delay of the departure of energy, i.e. delays cooling. In the process, no extraordinary global warming occurs. No energy is created in the process. CO2 in the atmosphere cools the best!
